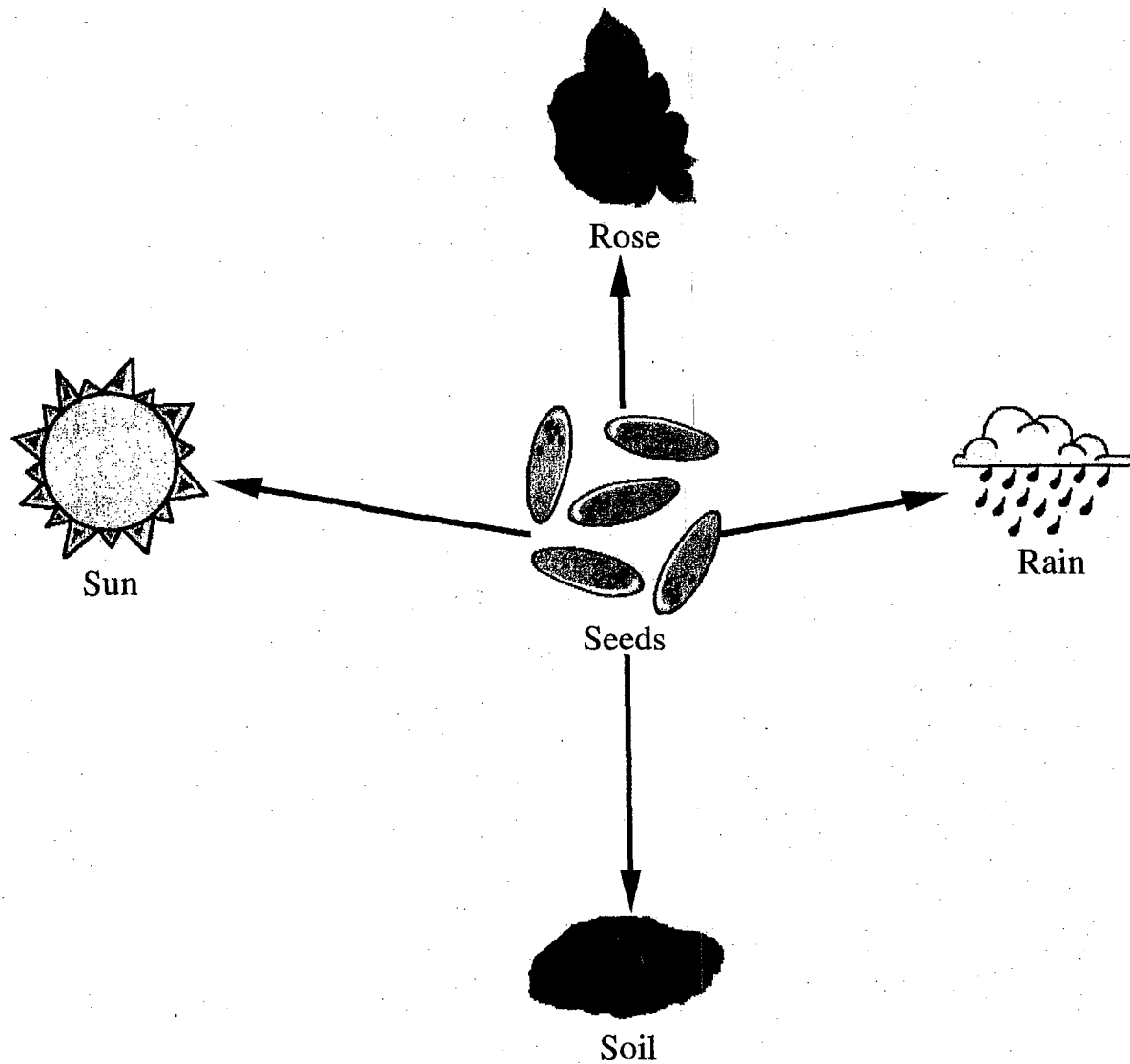

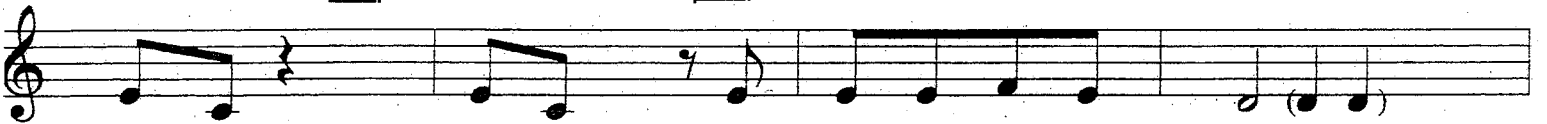

The Pickle Jar

Materials: pickle jar cards... one for each student participant

Rules:

1. Leader deals one card to each student face down
2. Students may look at their card but should not show it to another student.
3. The Leader gets three tries to discover who has the pickle.
4. If the pickle is found before the three tries are up... the leader picks another student to be the leader and the game starts over.
5. If the student holding the pickle is NOT caught, then that student becomes the leader (because the student fooled the leader).

Who Took The Pickle From The Pickle Jar?

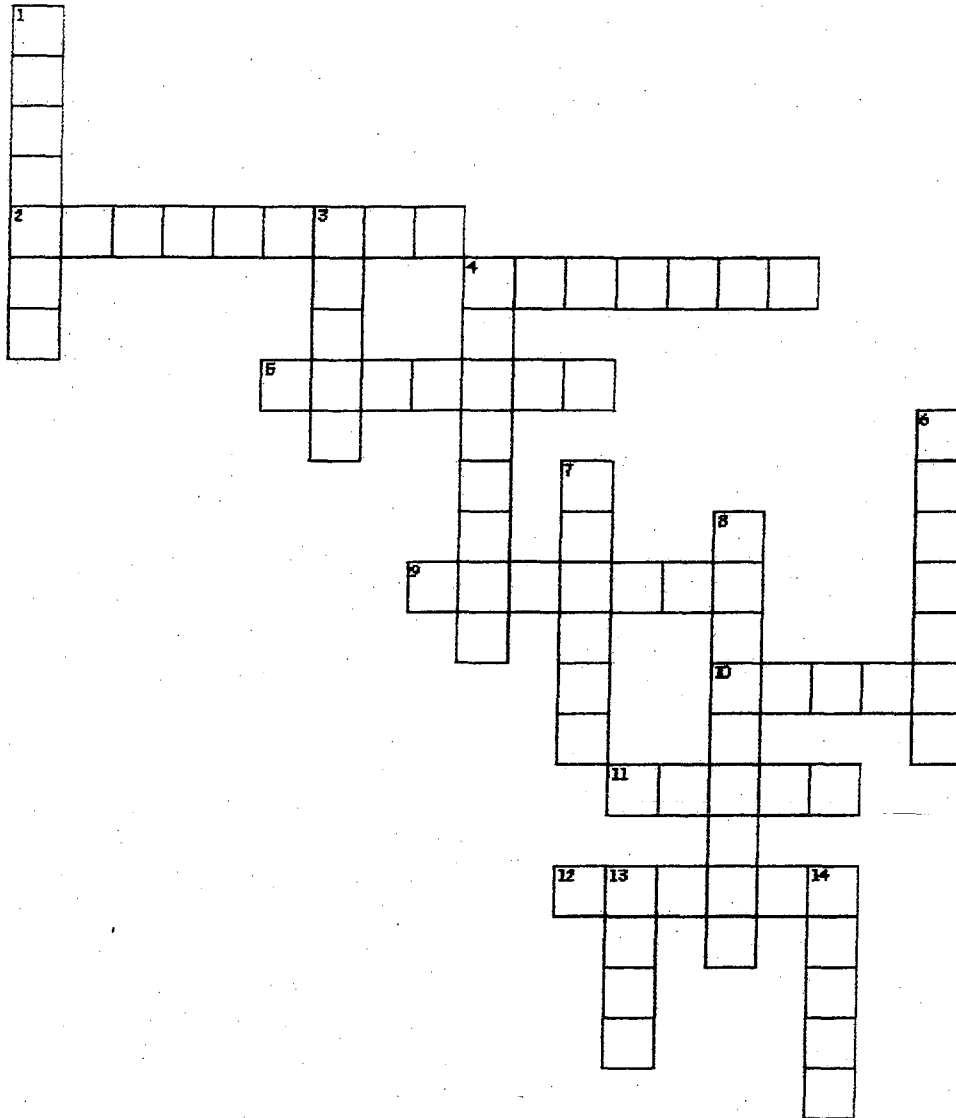
