Art in the Park is a series of six juried outdoor art festivals designed to benefit the member artists and the educational programs of the Naples Art Association, on the 1st Saturday of the month, November-April. All members are eligible for jury process. You must be a current member and commit to 2 hours of volunteer work for the Naples Art Association per show to participate. The deadlines for the one-time jury process, by slides or photos are: October 4, December 4 and February 4. These are only deadlines; jury process takes place later. There is a \$10.00 processing fee. After your work is approved you may apply to any show or shows that you wish.

The Naples Art Association at the von Liebig Art Center or any of their representatives shall not be held liable for loss or damage to any persons or properties while participating in these events. Artwork must be original in design and executed by the exhibitor. All work is juried on a fine art basis. Unacceptable items shall include but not be limited to craft items, all kits, green ware, t-shirts and tote bags. Exhibitor must make a % of beadwork elements. Reproductions must be clearly labeled as such. **ABSOLUTELY NO BUY-SELL**

Art in the **Park** Rules

To participate, you must know and follow these rules.

Art in the Park is a juried fine art festival for members of the Naples Art Association. *Eligibility requires a current NAA membership and at least two volunteer hours per show.* The show is held on Park Street alongside The von Liebig Art Center, normally on the first Saturday of the month, November through April, **rain or shine.** The show hours are from 10:00 AM until 4:00 PM. All work must remain on display during these hours, unless otherwise informed by the committee. In the event of afternoon threatening weather we may close early. If the morning weather is threatening we may delay setup. These decisions are made solely by the Art in the Park committee. **These are advertised events and are only canceled due to extremely severe weather.**

- Artwork must be original in design and executed by the exhibitor. All work is juried on a fine art basis. Reproductions of your work are allowed but must be labeled as such. Committee has the right to remove items deemed offensive or substandard, **COMMITTEE DECISIONS ARE FINAL.**
- A deposit of \$65 is required for each show, your application is due on Monday, prior to the show. Show fee is 10% on all sales attributable to the show over your deposit allowance. To properly cancel; call Tom Taylor at 435-0071 or Cell at 777-1150 before Friday, prior to event. “No shows” are nearly un-excusable, the first one is free, and the second is your last Art in the Park. A “NO SHOW” shall be defined as not canceling by Friday noon prior to the event. Please cancel as early as possible so we can adjust the layout accordingly.
- Remember; the commission due is calculated on all sales attributable to Art in the Park. If you are in doubt about it ask yourself, **“Would I have sold this if I hadn’t been in this show?”** If the answer is no then commission is due. This includes work seen at other venues and also work commissioned for delivery at a later date. Work sold at other venues and delivered at AP are not attributable.
- Your booth space is in line with and between the number tapes, it also includes all of the usable space to the rear. You may not infringe on another space physically or audibly. Artist must furnish all display materials and protective gear. A white 10’X10’ tent is required for all but your first event. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated.
- Setup is from 6:30 AM until 9:30: AM, no vehicle entry after 9: AM; space assignments are available at booth # 22, on Park Street. Unload quickly and move vehicle to the Woman’s Club South parking lot. Vehicles must be out of pedestrian area by 9:15 AM and re-enter only when authorized.

Envelopes are brought around in the morning, with commission forms to be turned in at the end of the show, whether or not you have sales. Remember this, it is very important. Instructions are on each form.

The Naples Art Association, The von Liebig Art Center, or any of their representatives shall not be held responsible for loss or damage to any persons or properties while participating in these events.

Before leaving the area, it is your job to turn in commission form and remove all debris, including cable ties and space number tape. Area should be better than when you arrived.
